1. Name and draw five senses animals use to communicate.

2. Name three methods leopards use to communicate.

Examples: Visual = Showing teeth, lowering ears, lifting tails

Auditory = Vocalisation trough sounds from mouth and nose eg. soft chirp, mew, sharp hiss, load sawing call

Olfactory = Spraying urine and smelling, defecating in prominent places, sent traces on scratched trees or scraped soil.

3. Give two examples of animals that use echolocation.

Examples: Bats, dolphins, whales, some birds, shrews

4. Give an example of an animal that uses seismic (vibration) communication.

Examples: Elephants, spiders, some frogs, moles, termites, bees and other insects
