2. Name three methods leopards use to communicate.

**Examples: Visual = Showing teeth, lowering ears, lifting tails**

**Auditory = Vocalisation through sounds from mouth and nose  
eg. soft chirp, mew, sharp hiss, loud sawing call**

**Olfactory = Spraying urine and smelling, defecating in  
prominent places, scent traces on scratched trees or scraped  
soil.**

3. Give two examples of animals that use echolocation.

**Examples: Bats, dolphins, whales, some birds, shrews**

4. Give an example of an animal that uses seismic (vibration)  
communication.

**Examples: Elephants, spiders, some frogs, moles, termites, bees and  
other insects**
