- Age categories are 10-13, 14-16 and 17-18.
- Each artwork must have a title, and the name of the artist must be accompanied by an entry form.
- A maximum of two entries per individual will be accepted, and 20 entries per school/organisation.
- Must be an original work done by entrant, following all guidelines.

RULES

By entering this competition, the entrant and their parent/guardian/representative agrees that the organisers have the right to print and frame the artwork after the competition to be sold and/or auctioned to raise funds for the education project. The organisers have the right to display the artwork in public places or at a Cape Leopard Trust event and auction a copy of the artwork. The entrant also agrees that the organisers have the right to keep all artworks and use the artwork in marketing material including social media. We regret that no artworks will be returned.

HOW TO SUBMIT

We require the original artworks, therefore entries need to be submitted via post to P.O. Box 31139, Tokai, 7966, Cape Town, before the closing date on Friday, 07 June.
