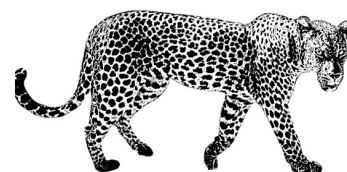




CALENDAR ART COMPETITION 'PREDATORS OF THE CAPE'

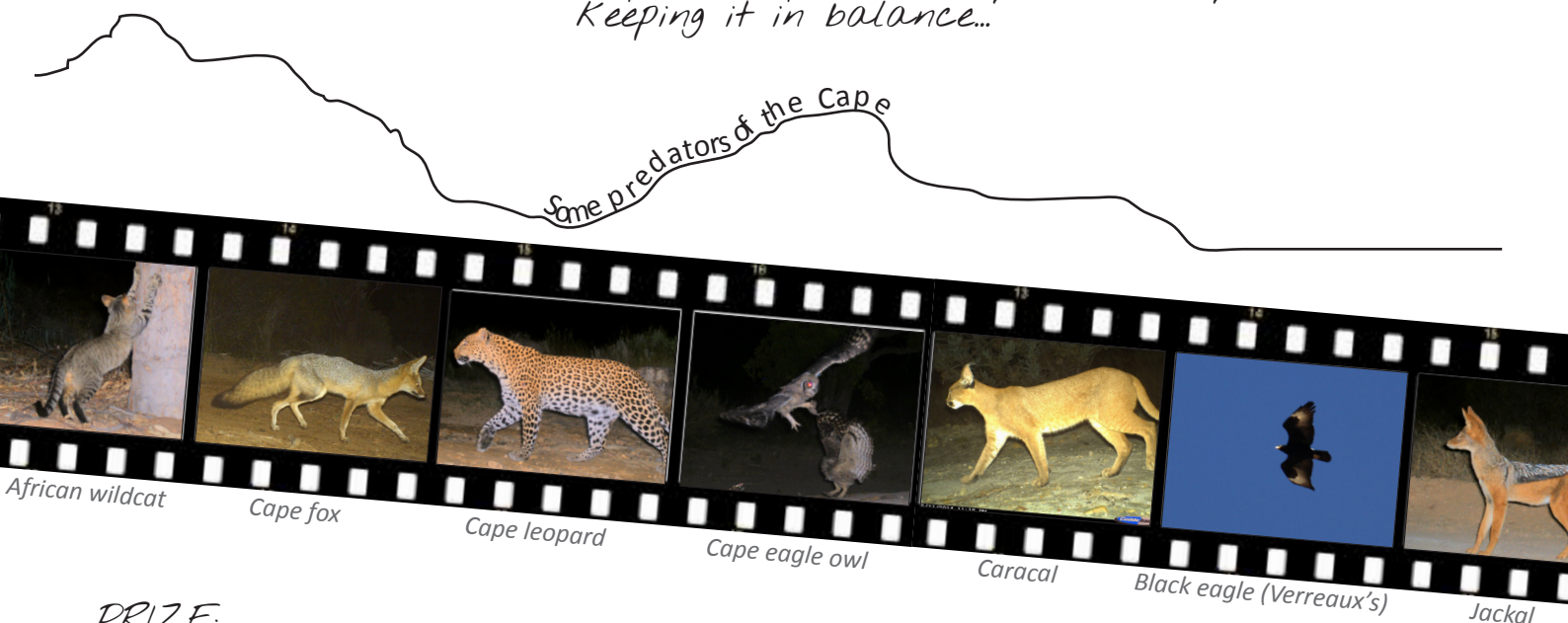
BE CREATIVE

CALENDAR ART COMPETITION

'PREDATORS OF THE CAPE'

THEME:

The theme is 'Predators of the Cape'. Predators play an important role in nature and this calendar will celebrate the predators that we find in the Cape. Your artwork may explore this theme in any way.

GUIDELINES AND RULES:

Drawings/paintings can be done in any medium (eg paint, pastel, charcoal, pencil, ink - please be sure to spray with hairspray or other fixative if using materials that smudge)

Size: Landscape orientation on A3 paper

Each piece must have an artwork name and accompanying line/paragraph of text (these must be filled in on the entry form, NOT on the artwork)

Judging criteria: relevance to theme; visual impact; genuine personal response; creativity; skill

Must be original work done by entrant, following guidelines above.

Anyone 18 or younger may enter the competition.

There is no limit on the number of entries.

Winning artworks will not be returned to entrants. All other artworks may be retrieved by arrangement from the Cape Leopard Trust delivery address.

In entering this competition the entrant and their parent/guardian/representative agrees that the organisers have the right to auction the artworks in aid of the Cape Leopard Trust's conservation and environmental education programme and to reproduce them to make a calendar and showcase the work on their and their sponsors' websites.

Artworks must be received by the closing date, **Friday 24th July 2015**.

Address is given on entry form.

Artwork must have a completed entry form attached to the back.
