To enter the competition, you are required to create a Leopard sculpture out of recycled, reused, or repurposed materials. The flashy trashy leopard can be blinged up, or dressed down with the creative use and adaptation of everyday items we would normally throw away.

Once your leopard is created, you need to submit an entry form with a maximum of 8 photos (of no more than 1mb each) of your sculpture to: competition@capeleopard.org.za before 31st of August 2020. The top three sculptures will be selected from each age category and we will take your pictures to the public to vote for the final winners.
